



## Pee Wee House Program

**Ages 11/12**

**Born 2006/2007**

Format: Players will be assessed at an initial player evaluation skate and then placed on balanced teams, usually 6-7 teams are formed with 14-18 players per team.

Teams will have 1-2 practices per week and either a home or away game each week. The teams are entered in to the Fraser Valley West League governed by [PCAHA](#), and games will be anywhere from Delta to Aldergrove.

Teams will also normally enter 1-2 local tournaments per season, some teams participate in some travel events, generally within close driving distance. SEMI Hockey also hosts a Christmas break Pee Wee House tournament.

Coaching: Pee Wee house teams are led by parent volunteer coaches. These coaches are required to obtain coaching certification from [BC Hockey](#) as well as undergo Criminal Record clearance. In addition there will be several practices throughout the season led by SEMI Hockey Professional coaches.

Eligibility: In order to maximize enjoyment and success in this Hockey program, incoming players are expected to have basic skating skills prior to the season, either in an Initiation Hockey program, skating lessons or 20 hours previous skating experience.

Start dates: Evaluation skates will start the second weekend of September

Volunteer participation is expected and could include roles such as:

- Coach
- Assistant coaches
- On ice helpers
- Managers
- Tournament coordinators
- Jersey distribution
- Others, ask team manager, or check with SEMI Hockey office
